ABOUT PCCP DIVISION

Resonance launched Pre-foundation Career Care Programs (PCCPs) Division in 2006 with the philosophy of an early start. As the name suggests, the division aims at giving the edge to the students for Career Examinations like JEE (Main + Advanced), NEET/ AIIMS, CA/CS/CLAT etc. before entering into senior secondary classes.

In last 12 years, PCCP division has evolved significantly and works in two segments of classes, namely, Sub-Junior classes (V – VIII) and Junior classes (IX – X). The two segments have different teaching methodologies and so are their targets.

In junior classes, the targeted competitive examinations are National Standard Examination in Junior Science (NSEJS, 1st stage of International Junior Science Olympiad (IJSO)), National Talent Search Examination (NTSE), Pre Regional Mathematics Olympiad (PreRMO, 1st stage of International Mathematics Olympiad). In addition to these competitive examinations, we also prepare students for class X board examination, according to the latest changes made in it, by exposing them to mock situations like that of the real one.

In Sub-Junior classes, the targeted competitive examinations are National Mathematics Talent Competitions (NMTTC), Private Mathematics and Science Olympiads and other private Olympiads which can be cleared by following CBSE curriculum of the particular class. Other than the competitive examinations, we build conceptual understanding in all the subjects by following NCERT curriculum and conducting various academic workshops to make students understand the application of several concepts.

Other than the academic delivery of concepts in Sub-Junior classes, we also aim at inculcating life skills in students as per the current guidelines of World Health Organization (WHO). The life skills include social skills, thinking skills and emotional skills. These skills are enhanced through a variety of activities conducted at the campus of each study center of Resonance.

Pre-defined Yearly Planner

The yearly planner consists of arrayed chapters for each subjects, test grid of whole session with syllabus mentioned in it, holiday schedule, homework checking schedule, etc.



All India Testing

The concepts learnt and practiced by the students are tested through regular tests mentioned in the yearly planner and conducted among the students of Resonance across all the study centers. This helps students to check their performance at the national level.

Scientifically Designed Chapter Modules

Classroom teaching is supplemented with futuristic study material in the form of chapter modules, which provide sequential theory of a particular chapter with exercises to check the progress of students, pictorial and textual summaries.



School Examination Preparatory (SEP) Sheets

These are worksheets which are to be solved and submitted for checking, after each chapter.



Regular Classroom Discussion of Homework Questions

After classroom teaching, homework is given to students, which is discussed in the next class of that particular subject. Students who do regular homework and participate in classroom discussion are likely to succeed in the competitive examinations.



Clinic Classes & Doubt Classes

Clinic and Doubt classes are for those students who miss out on classes due to unavoidable circumstances or late joining. These classes run throughout the year so that students can catch up anytime they feel left out.



Enhanced Classroom Teaching with Learning Aids

In classrooms, faculty members employ latest technologies to deliver topics in the most interesting and possible manner to maximize the absorption of concepts.



Daily Practice Problems (DPPs)

In addition to chapter modules, DPPs are given to students. Each DPP includes questions from all the chapters taught before it, even if they've already been covered in earlier DPPs.

21ST CENTURY SUPPORT AND COMMUNICATION MECHANISM

Psychological cum Academic Counselling

At times, students get stuck within their personal problems and need guidance to overcome that situation. In this scenario, we conduct one-to-one psychological-cum-academic counselling sessions for these students in which their problems are discussed and customized solutions are given to them.

Motivational Sessions

There is provision of motivational classes within the curriculum which is required to keep the students on track and motivate them to aspire for success. As students of this age require continuous guidance, these motivation sessions help them to set their targets and fix the execution guidelines to achieve them.

Parent Teacher & Student Meeting (PTSM)

There is a provision of PTSM which ensures periodic communication among the parents, teachers and students. Through this meeting, parents get feedback about the strengths and weaknesses of their ward and teachers get feedback about their teaching. This mutual feedback system helps in improving the quality of academic delivery.



Student Observation Report (SOR)

In case, any student, out of ignorance, indulges in any disobedient act or doesn't complete the allotted homework properly, faculty members fill SOR which is communicated to the parents for their action and discussion with the staff of Resonance.

Student Relationship Manager (SRM)

It is basically a WhatsApp contact number used to connect with parents to inform them about daily updates, test syllabus information, homework information, workshop notification, competitive examination registration etc. The information is floated through WhatsApp images and text messages. SRM ensures that parents do not miss out on any of the information being shared by Resonance.

Google Calendar

The yearly course planner is converted into Google Calendar and is available for parents to sync it with calendar in their device. Through this calendar, parents get alerts of the upcoming events like tests and activities.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

A co-curricular activity essentially takes place outside the typical pen & pencil classroom experience. Here, they are purposefully designed for giving an opt combination of students' participation in academics and also making an opportunity for overall growth. The exposure achieved through these activities cannot be achieved alone by theoretical means.

Through activities, we aim to promote life skills. The ten Life Skills can be categorized into three core groups as depicted below:

LIFE SKILLS



THINKING SKILLS

Self Awareness, Problem Solving, Decision Making, Critical Thinking, Creative Thinking.

These include decision-making, problem-solving skills and information gathering skills. An individual must be skilled in evaluating the future consequences of their present actions on others. They need to be able to determine alternative solutions and to analyze the influence of their values not only on their own but also on others around them.



SOCIAL SKILLS

Interpersonal Relationships, Effective Communication, Empathy.

These include verbal and non-verbal communication, active listening, and the ability to express feelings and to give feedback. Also this category covers negotiation/refusal skills and assertiveness skills that directly affect one's ability to manage conflicts. Empathy, which is the ability to listen and understand other's needs and problems, is also a key interpersonal skill. Moreover, Team work and the ability to cooperate, express respect for those around us.



EMOTIONAL SKILLS

Managing Feelings/ Emotions, Dealing with Stress.

These refer to skills which help one to increase the internal focus of control over feelings and their expressions, so that the individual can believe that she/he can affect change around and make a difference in the world.

WORKSHOPS

The purpose of workshop is to provide a platform for active learning. This learning goes beyond the horizons of textbooks in three ways; higher application of concepts in competitive examinations, nurturing skills acquired over the period of passive learning and applying the concepts through various activities and experiments.

These workshops serve as platform to students for upgrading their knowledge level in a way that increases their ability to perform in different realms.

We offers several types of such workshops throughout the year. Preparation for these exams is quite tough but with perfect guidance, it can be attained easily.

Terms & Conditions

Resonance National Entrance Test (ResoNET)

- ▶ ResoNET registration closes 4 days before the Test date.
- ▶ To take admission in particular Classroom Programme & Phase, the students can appear in any two ResoNET by paying **reappearance fee ₹ 200** & the best of those would be considered for preparing the Final Merit List. His/her roll no. would remain the same for all the tests.
- ▶ The ResoNET result will be declared within 6 days of conduction of exam. It will be announced on our website www.pccp.resonance.ac.in and also communicated through SMS.
- ▶ The decision of Resonance will be final in all respects and no communication will be entertained.
- ▶ Resonance reserves the right to change, or cancel this test at any time, without any prior notice.
- ▶ The Application Form Fee paid by student shall not be refunded in any case.

Scholarship

- ▶ The scholarship is valid for one year only i.e. for academic session: 2019-20 (Availed or Not availed)
- ▶ The scholarships shall be applicable to a student only after taking admission in respective program (at Kota/Authorized Study Centre of Resonance across India).
- ▶ Student can avail only **best of one scholarship** in case he/she is eligible for more than one scholarship under different criteria by Resonance through any other scholarship program.
